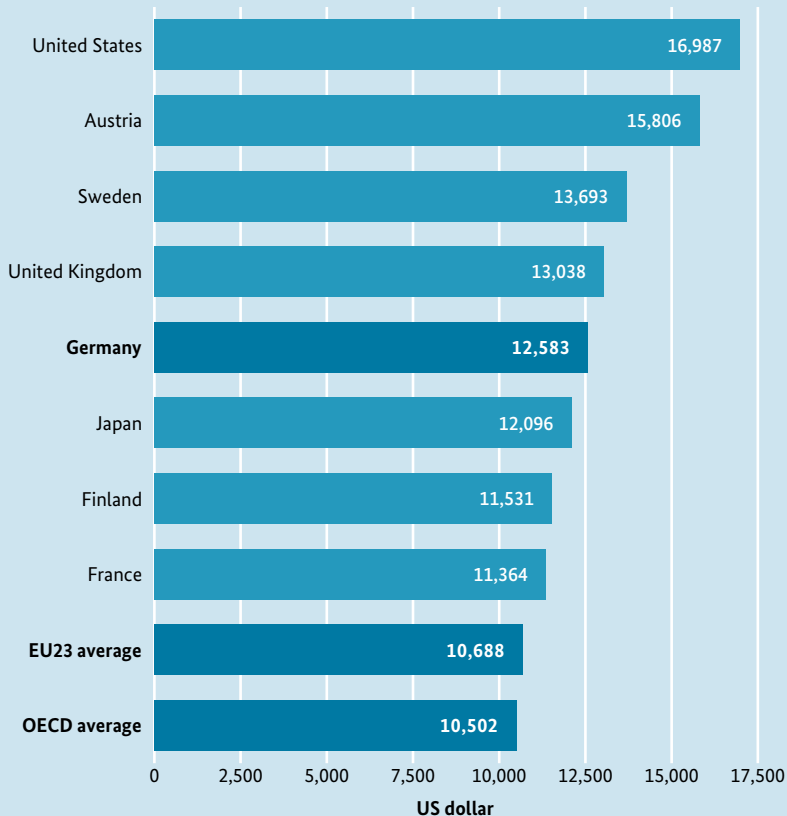


Fig. 62 Annual expenditure on educational institutions per pupil/student from primary to tertiary education, in selected OECD countries (2016)¹

1) Expenditure at a particular level of education is calculated by dividing the total expenditure on educational institutions at that level by the corresponding full-time equivalent enrolment. Expenditure is converted into equivalent US dollar by dividing the national currency figure by the purchasing power parity (PPP) index for the gross domestic product (GDP). The 2016 exchange rate for Germany between US dollar (PPP) and euro was 1.301.
