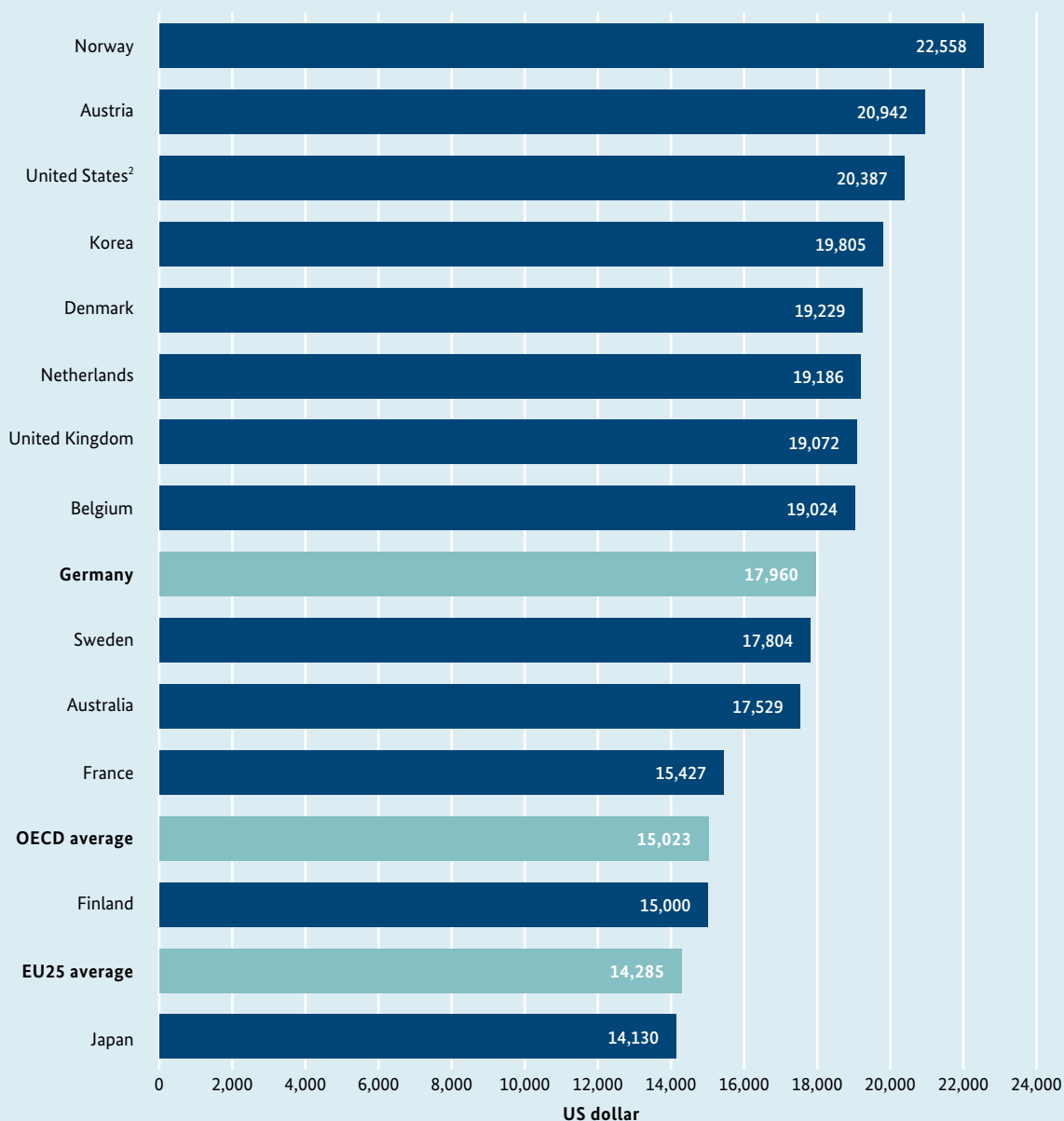


Chart 2.1.17a Annual expenditure on educational institutions per pupil/student from primary to tertiary education, in selected OECD countries (2022)¹

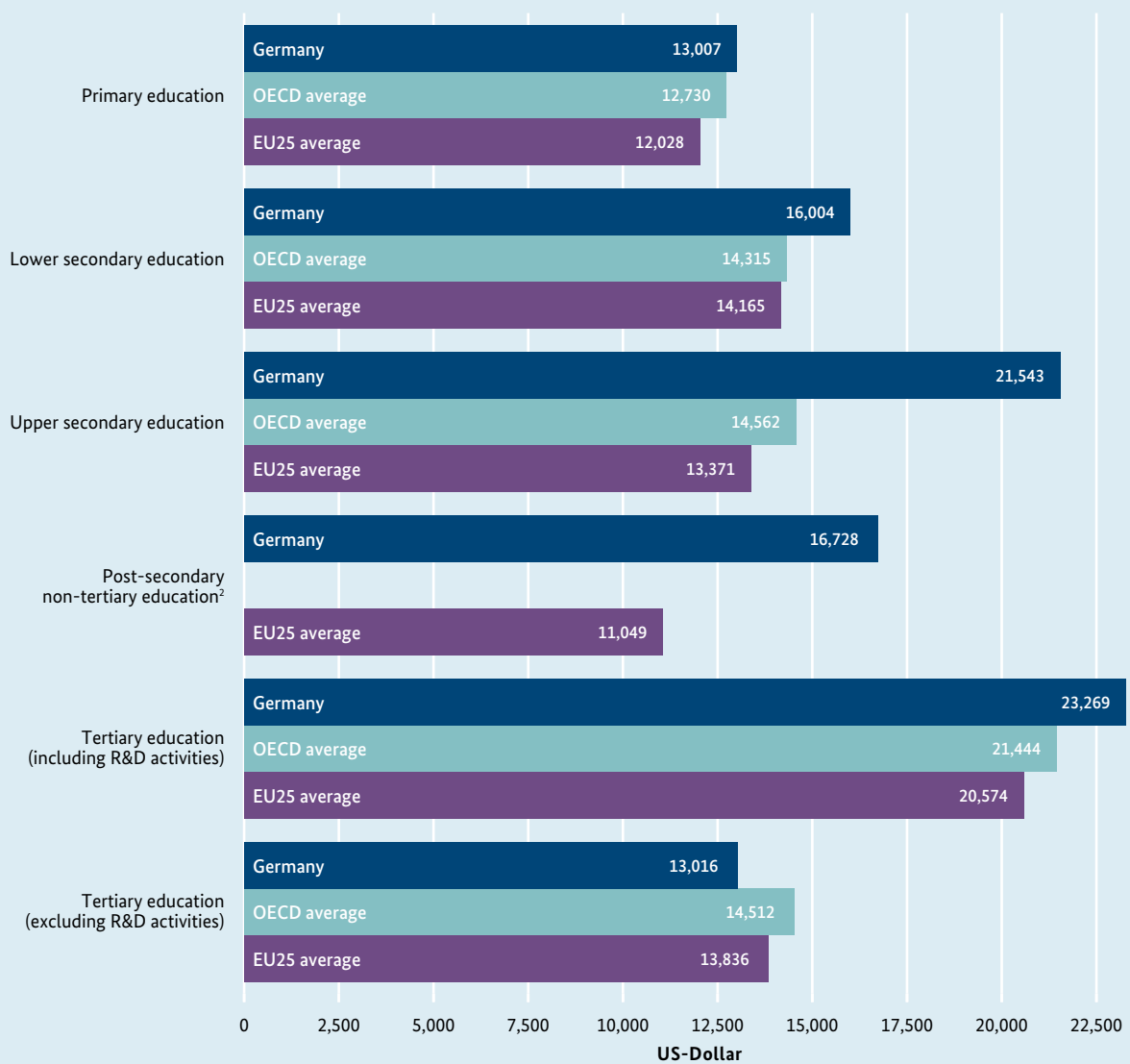
